**b) ORCGA Best Practice Proposal - 3-26**

**5. Review Proposed CCGA TR's**

**a) CCGA Best Practice Proposal – TR – 114 (ATLCGA)**

- Committee accepted the word “planner” throughout
- Committee did not approve the wording “above and underground” and would like to stay with Utility, felt that it covered everything.
- His/her should be changed to “their”

**b) CCGA Best Practice Proposal – TR – 115 (ATLCGA)**

- Committee began a review of the proposal
- Committee agrees with most of the word changes which reflect the changes made in the current manual and other publications.

**c) CCGA Best Practice Proposal – TR – 116 (ATLCGA)**

- Committee responded to the proposed Practice Statement and approve the expanded title
- Committee felt this proposal as just editorial and not improving the content. The last addition is already an accepted practice in many provinces, not sure if the statement is meant to drive compliance.

**d) CCGA Best Practice Proposal – TR – 117 (BCCGA)**

- Committee agrees with the proposed TR
- Committee is still debating the justifications in the practice description
